







These can be cut and used prior to teaching:

carnivore	Organism that can produce its own food by photosynthesis	
herbivore	Organisms that cannot produce their own food, opposite of producer	
omnivore	An animal that eats mostly plants	
producer	Breaks down dead/decaying matter and then absorbs the resulting molecules, returning the nutrients to the environment	
consumer	An animal that eats mostly meat	
decomposer	Obtain nutrients by eating detritus (decomposing organic matter)	
detritivore	Eating a mixture between plants and meat
